Public computer workstations

LSM computer workstations allow access to Rutgers University Libraries networked resources, online catalog, etc. It is recommended that you bring USB flash drives (i.e. disk-on-key type devices) with you for downloading purposes. Our computers are Windows compatible and do not support zip disks. Application software, such as MS Word, etc are not available on these workstations.

Borrowing and Interlibrary Loan

The Rutgers University Libraries do not offer a research or searching service. The Rutgers University Libraries collections are available to the public for on-site use. (An exception: the SciFinder Scholar portal for Chemical Abstracts searching is contractually restricted to current Rutgers faculty, staff and students).

To borrow books owned by the Rutgers University Libraries, a company representative may telephone the Rutgers University Libraries Interlibrary Loan Department (732/932-8345(x349) and inquire about corporate services, procedures and fees.
