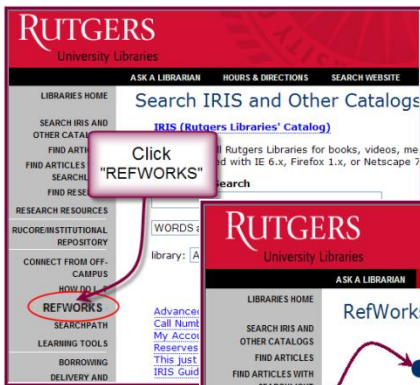
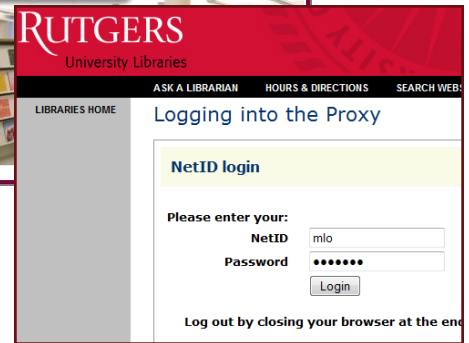


RefWorks: Logging in as a Rutgers User

RefWorks is a web-based bibliography and citation manager that is available free of charge to Rutgers students and faculty. It allows you to organize your research, import references, include citations while writing your paper and create a bibliography according to many different styles.

To get started using RefWorks, start with the libraries web page; libraries.rutgers.edu. If you are working remotely, please remember to login with your NetID on the top left of the page.

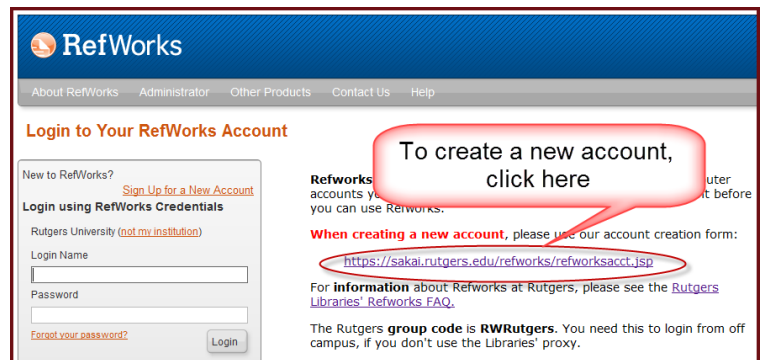


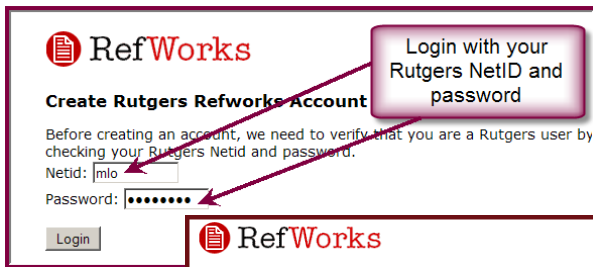

Click on "REFWORKS" in the gray column on the left of the page, towards the middle. Then click on "Connect" at the top of the page.

To create a new account, you will need to use the "account creation form" from the link on this page.

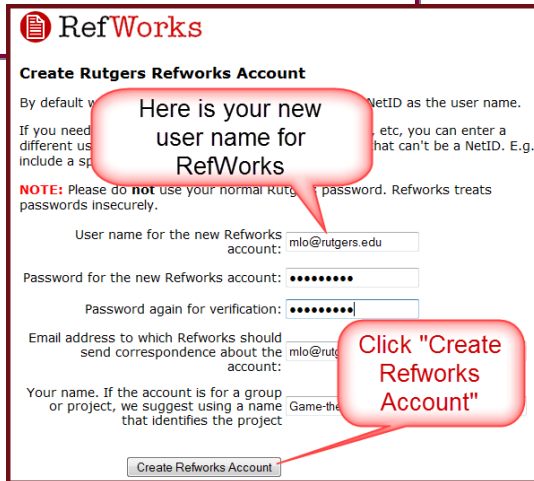

Initially you will login with your NetID and password. Your user name for RefWorks will be your NetID plus "@rutgers.edu". You will also need to select a new password for RefWorks.

Click on "Create a RefWorks Account" at the bottom of the page.
