

RUTGERS UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES PRIORITIES, 2015-2017

At the State of the Libraries meeting in November 2015, vice president for information services and university librarian Krisellen Maloney announced the following priorities for 2016-2017.

- Clarify communication and decision-making
 - Review RUL faculty bylaws
 - Connect activities to AUL/AVP/Directors
 - Improve Cabinet effectiveness
 - o Increase budget transparency

• Enhance undergraduate support

- o Refine reference services to ensure robust and comprehensive availability
- o Assess instructional participation across the undergraduate curriculum
- o Launch open textbook initiatives
- Define the Libraries role in and identify resources for advanced research support
 - o Collaborate with Office of Research and Economic Development
 - o Coordinate activities and inventory existing services
 - o Support federal mandates for public access and openly accessible data
 - o Obtain funding for needed services

• Conduct a holistic review of special collections

- o Improve access and discovery, in-person and remote
- o Evaluate processes for acquisition, conservation, description, digitization
- o Ensure space is adequate and proper
- Optimize collection development and management
 - Support central and local needs in four areas: undergraduate support, special collections, RBHS, and CIC Large-Scale Acquisitions
 - o Develop a collections master plan
 - o Build collection assessment capacities to support decision-making
