Tunnel Book Workshop Supply List

We will be making two versions of a tunnel book; one with multiple copies of a photograph and one with colored paper. You can choose to prepare materials for however many books you want to make.

General materials:


Ruler

Pencil

Bonefolder (or popsicle stick if you don't have one)

Scissor or xacto knife

PVA glue and brush (or glue stick if you don't have PVA)




Photographic Tunnel Book:

One piece cut paper 4"x 13" (grain short) - preferably heavier weight

5 @ 4 x 6 copies of an image with multiple elements (for example a family photo with scenery) It is preferable

that they are printed on photo paper (grain short).

2 @ 8" x 4" paper cut grain short. This can be copier paper weight.




One piece cut paper 5"x 15" (grain short) - preferably heavier weight

5 @ 5 x 7 (grain short) sheets of colored paper - can be construction paper - heavier is better

Magazines for collage elements

2 @ 8" x 5" paper cut grain short. This can be copier paper weight.



If you want to make a hard cover for either book you will need:

Book cloth approx. 10 x 20

2 pieces cardboard 4 x 6 grain short for photographic book (grain long)

2 pieces cardboard 5 x 7 grain short for colored paper book (grain long)

(You can use cardboard from the back of a writing pad or thick food packaging cardboard)
