



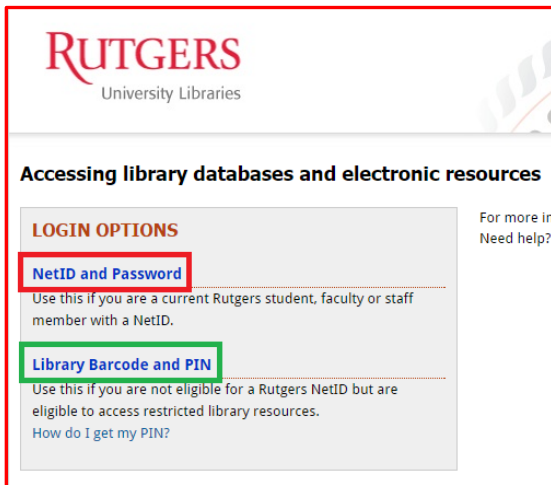
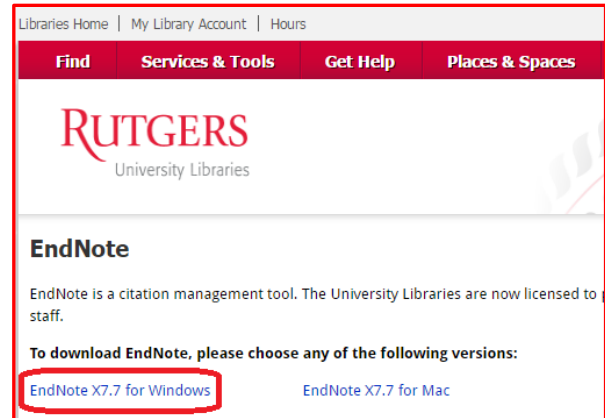
Do I Need a Product Key to Install EndNote?

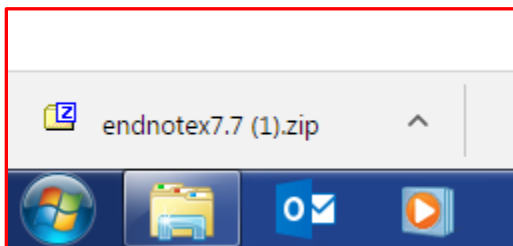
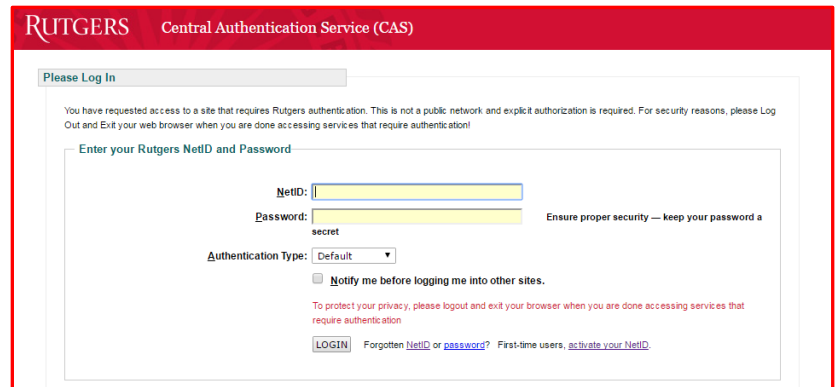
I was trying to install the **EndNote program for Windows** on my computer, but I got a message asking me to enter a product key for EndNote or evaluate it. Do I need a product key to install EndNote?

Answer:

No, you are not supposed to be prompted to enter a product key if you are a Rutgers user. The University Libraries are licensed to provide download access to EndNote for all Rutgers users. If you are eligible and have your NetID, you may click [HERE](#) to download EndNote as shown on the right. Choose **EndNote X7.7 for Windows** to download it.

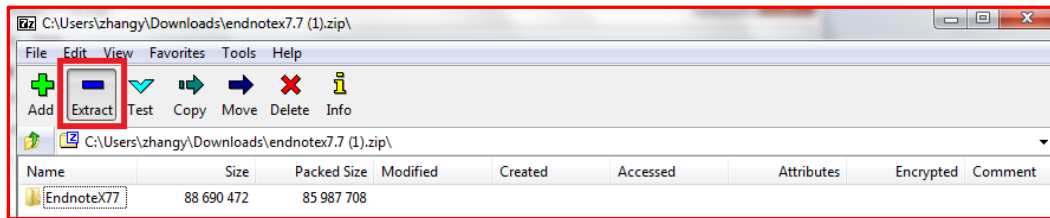


At the Accessing page, choose the NetID and Password option (or the other option depending on your status). Then you enter your NetID and Password at the login page as shown below.

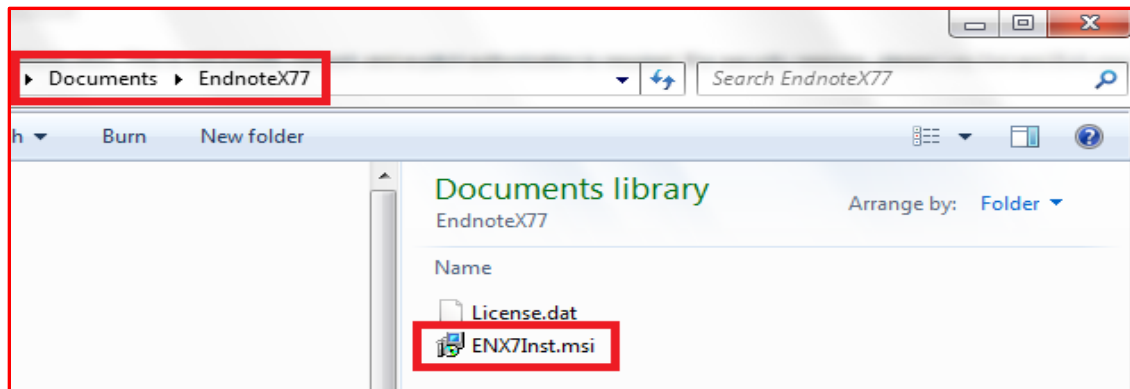


The zipped file will be downloaded to your computer shown at the lower left corner on the screen. By default, the zipped file will be placed in the Downloads folder. But you may move the file to your desktop or another directory.

To unzip the file, click the zipped file that you just downloaded. In the following window, click the Extract button to extract all the files.



It is important to place all the extracted files in a different directory as shown below. You may place in the Documents folder or Desktop.



Make sure the license file and the installer (in this case, it's the ENX7Inst file) are placed in the same folder. Then click **ENX7Inst.msi** as shown above to install the program. EndNote will be automatically installed under **C:\Program Files [x86]\EndNote**.
