



Scopus

Scopus is a citation and abstract database of peer-reviewed literature that can be used by researchers to determine the impact of specific authors, articles/documents, and journals. It contains over 50 million records in the areas of science, technology, medicine, social sciences, arts, and humanities. Titles included in Scopus are selected based on journal policies, content, journal standing, regularity of publication, and online availability.
